Dear Beatitudes Campus Family,

On Saturday, March 28, 2020, we were notified of a presumptive positive COVID-19 laboratory result for an Independent Living resident from our community.

The resident who lives in Central Park South has been quarantined at home since exhibiting symptoms on Wednesday, March 25, 2020. All precautions are being made for any staff or health care personnel who need to be in contact with the resident.

Due to this, we are moving to the next level of precautions for the campus. We will be working closely with the Maricopa County Department of Public Health and will continue to follow all the procedures recommended by the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention. We want to make residents, their families and our dedicated staff aware of this situation and reassure everyone that we are on top of it.

We promised you that we will be transparent and inform you as situations develop at the campus. There is no cause for panic or alarm. Our focus remains on the health and well-being of our community and we will do this to the best of our ability. We must also recognize our team for the concern and commitment they have shown to our residents during this challenging time. Our mission has never been more meaningful.

We informed all residents of this situation on Saturday, March 28. There will be a few changes as we elevate our precautions. Effective immediately, all meals from Bistro or Buckwald's will be delivered to residents' apartments only; pick-ups will be unavailable. Grocery/Supply items from the Bistro Store will also be available for delivery. Additionally, if you live locally and are dropping off groceries, prescriptions or packages to your family at the campus, please drop them off at the main entrance as you have been doing, and the campus team will deliver them to your family member's apartment. Out of an abundance of caution, we will not call your family member to pick up any packages.
