Your safety and security – physically, emotionally and spiritually – continues to be our highest concern. Recommended precautions from the CDC and state and local government are evolving by the hour. We are monitoring the Federal and State directives and recommendations and it is now necessary to raise, yet again, our preventative measures. There is no question that these restrictions are unprecedented and limiting, but they are introduced with every desire to minimize any resident from having to endure a life threatening illness. Your health and safety and that of our staff and community, is our top priority. Please watch the Beatitudes Community Channel for the latest actions, as we will not always be sending out letters.


Here is the current list of new restrictions we are putting in place as of today. They will remain in effect for the next 15 days unless extended:

- **No visitors** will be allowed on campus unless they are essential to your healthcare.
- **All dining venues will be closed** beginning dinnertime March 17th. We are prepared to take your orders and deliver your meals if you are unable to pick them up. The Bistro cash registers will be closed for orders – phone orders will be the only option. We are making plans for the Grab & Go to remain open. Please be patient as this is a huge undertaking. Our hope is to maintain our full-menu options. Stay tuned for more details to come on the Community Channel. Eating well will only strengthen your immune system.
- All **hair salons are closed** until further notice.
- **The Fitness Center is closed.** Please tune into channel 1-2 for fitness classes. Keeping yourself physically fit is excellent preventative medicine.
- **Grocery runs will no longer be offered.** Family and friends dropping off food and supplies will be directed to leave your items with your name and apartment number on it outside the Welcome Center entrance and we will deliver the package to you. We are setting up procedures for possible grocery delivery services if needed. Again, watch the community channel for details.
- **No outside, privately contracted housekeepers** will be allowed at this time. If you need housekeeping, please call Housekeeping and arrange for temporary service.
- If you have been using Beatitudes at Home companions, please continue to do so and do not sacrifice your health by cancelling this service. Our staff is checked every day and will be taking extreme precautions to keep you safe.
- If you are using external caregivers, make sure they have been checked and received a dated visitor's sticker.
- **All trips off campus are highly discouraged.**

- **The Gift Shop is closed** temporarily, as is the **Backstreet Boutique**.
- **The Healthcare Center and Plaza View are officially on lockdown.** No one may enter those buildings for any reason. This includes the Plaza View Dining Room.
- **The 17th Drive entrance will be closed.** All cars entering the campus must go through the front entrance. If you should leave campus, please be aware that you will have to have your temperature checked and answer other vetting questions upon your return to campus.
- If you do not have a thermometer but feel you have a fever and want to have it checked, please contact Kathy Amend at x16192.
- If you need toilet tissue, we have rolls (limit one) available at the Grab and Go

As difficult as this is for all of us, if it lessens the chance of our community being infected with the virus, it will be worth it. Please remember, these are *temporary* measures. We will be back to the active and thriving community where residents socialize and gather whenever they want bringing smiles and joy along the way.
