### **Beginning Saturday morning May 30**

#### **Swimming Pool**

##### **Hours: All Day (Maximum 3 residents)**

- Will not be staffed. Residents will need to “police” themselves.
- Residents will wipe down touched areas after use.
- Practice social distancing of at least 6 feet.
- Locker rooms remain closed.

#### **Life Center Walking**

##### **Hours: Open Daily 6 – 11 am (Limit 3 households)**

- Staff will not be present.
- **30 minute time limit if someone is waiting.**
- Masks must be worn unless restricting breathing.
- Practice social distancing of at least 6ft.

## **Beginning Monday June 1**

### **Fitness Center**

**Hours Open: 9-11 am and 1-3 pm (Maximum 3 residents)**

Fitness Attendant monitoring the room during open hours

- Residents must sanitize hands before entering fitness center.
- Masks must be worn at all times unless restricting breathing.
- Residents will sign the Log-in sheet at every visit.
- Residents must wipe down equipment after each use.
- **There is a 30-minute limit when other residents are waiting.**
- Practice social distancing of at least 6 feet.

### **Library**

**Hours Open: Monday through Saturday from 1-3 pm**

- One resident will be allowed in at a time (other than the librarian).
- Residents will use hand sanitizer before entering and will wear masks while in the library.
- Librarians will handle the books and check them out. (Residents are asked not to touch the books on the shelves independently).
- Residents and librarian will practice social distancing while checking out books.
- Library computers and lounge chairs will not be available at this time.

## **Housekeeping (optional)**

### **Monthly**

- Housekeeping will reopen for one cleaning per resident a month. Housekeeping will call to confirm. You may decline housekeeping.
- Any resident can call the coordinators to cancel housekeeping or leave a note on their door if they want to cancel.
- Housekeepers will wear a disposable mask and gloves to clean each apartment.
- Residents will wear a mask and social distance or leave their apartment for cleaning.

## **Resident Lobbies**

- Resident Lobbies will be available with strict social distancing practices.
- A maximum of 3 residents in each lobby will be observed.
- Practice social distancing of at least 6ft distancing (unless a couple).
- Masks must be worn at all times.

## **Spiritual Life**

### **Distribution of Holy Communion**

- Those wishing to receive Holy Communion at the door of their own apartment may contact Chaplain Peggy, ext. 16109. Communion will be distributed on Wednesdays via the consecrated bread only at this time. Holy Communion will be consecrated by Chaplain Andrew and Chaplain Peggy.

### **Quiet Room**
