To Our Residents and Family Members:

Good Evening,

We were notified that another one of our residents on the fourth floor has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual, as soon as symptoms presented was immediately transferred to the ISO unit per protocol, testing was performed, and a call was received today at 5:15PM with positive results. The resident's roommate has been isolated to the now private room and is being monitored for any signs, symptoms, or temperature increase, since the roommate was transferred to the ISO unit. As of now, that resident has not shown any signs or symptoms and both of our positive residents have remained stable. Staff screening will continue.

As with the last resident positive, Public Health recommends at this present time to continue the infection control practices we have had in place for the past 3+ months. As previously stated on Tuesday, June 16, COVID-19 testing (viral-nose swab test) was administered to 166 Health Care Center staff. As of today, we have not received the results from these swab tests, but as soon as they are returned us, we will be giving an update of those results and any new plans or processes we will be implementing.

We are encouraging and reminding our staff to limit their exposure to crowds, to make sure they are wearing a mask when they are out in any public setting. This preventative practice will benefit both our residents and our staff.
