

Updated Beatitudes Campus Independent Living Resident Guidelines

In addition to essential medical and veterinarian appointments, curbside pick-ups, drive-thru, golf, and tennis, IL residents will now be able to go off-Campus for salon/barber appointments, grocery shopping, indoor bank and postal services, and MVD/car maintenance and upkeep services.

When going off-Campus to a medical appointment or the salon, you may have any friend or family member pick you up to take you, as we feel it is especially important to have support at medical appointments and hair/nail appointments have become a self-care necessity for many residents.

However, when going off-Campus for any of the other approved off-Campus destinations (salon/barber, grocery shopping, banking, MVD/car maintenance and upkeep services), you may only use the following modes of transportation at this time:

- Drive yourself
- Drive with another Beatitudes resident
- Drive with a family member/friend who is on the Campus approved caregiver list
- Drive with a Beatitudes at Home Companion
- Dial-a-Ride City of Phoenix ADA service

Taxis, Uber, and Lyft MAY NOT be used for transportation to off-Campus destinations at this time.

Grocery Store Guidelines

Residents will still be able to order seven grocery items each week and drop offs from loved ones will continue to be delivered to residents.

For those interested in going off-Campus for grocery shopping, please keep the following safety tips in mind:

- Consider where you wish to shop and call ahead to be sure they are practicing strict safety guidelines
- Bring a list to expedite your shopping
- Wear a facemask at all times and only shop in stores requiring facemasks
- Carry your own sanitizing supplies or be sure to use the sanitizing wipes provided by the store to sanitize your cart or basket before shopping
- Practice social distancing of 6 ft. at all times with other shoppers and employees
- Wash your hands for 20 seconds in warm water after returning from the store and putting away groceries

What to expect when grocery shopping:

- You may be asked to enter and exit through different locations
- A greeter at the door may make sure shoppers are wearing masks upon entry
- Carts may be sanitized for you
- Signage on the floor at check-out lines indicate 6 ft. markers to ensure proper social distancing

Salon Guidelines

On Campus

The Beatitudes Campus salons have reopened with COVID precautions in place:

- Only one customer is being served at a time
- Do not arrive for your appointment until you have received a call from the Salon that they are ready for you
- You may not wait in front of the Salon or in lobbies for your appointment
- Do not knock on the door
- Masks must be worn at all times
- Call #16193 to schedule an appointment.
 - The salon is experiencing a high call volume at this time. Please leave a message and **wait** until the salon calls you back

Off Campus

Before going to a salon off-Campus, call ahead and make sure the salon/barber has:

- Mask requirements for all stylists, staff, and patrons
- Hand sanitizing available
- No waiting in the lobby
- No additional guests allowed
- No charge for rescheduling
