Dear Beatitudes Families and Residents,

Good afternoon/evening all. I wanted to begin with coronavirus vaccine news. CVS, in partnership with Maricopa County Health Services (MCHS), administered Moderna vaccines to our Assisted Living and Early Memory residents on January 26, 2021. Residents who received their vaccines were monitored and most have reported minimal to moderate symptoms that resolved after 24 hours. There are a handful of residents that still have improving soreness to the vaccine site and some improving general aches. Those who received their first dose on Tuesday will receive their second dose on February 23, 2021. Residents who were unable to receive their vaccine on Tuesday, either by having to wait 14 days after recovering from COVID-19 or were otherwise unable to receive it on Tuesday, will receive their first Moderna vaccination dose on February 23, 2021. The clinic will then return to campus on March 23, 2021 to finish the vaccination process.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to the families of our three residents who succumbed with their fight against COVID-19. We also wish for a speedy recovery for the residents and staff who are currently bravely battling COVID-19.

We continue to test twice weekly with our staff and residents, and we have had no new cases of COVID-19. We are working closely with Maricopa County and Az Department of Health Services (AzDHS) while under the quarantine protocol. I will send correspondence when we are able to ease into the normal COVID-19 restricted visitations, designated essential visits and small group activities.

Plaza View Assisted Living

On January 25, 2021, we completed all staff and all resident testing in Assisted Living and had positive results for one resident and one Dining Services employee. On January 28, 2021, we tested all staff and residents, and we had positive COVID-19 results for one resident and one dining services employee. The curve in Assisted Living and Early Memory seems to be declining, which is the trend we have been working hard for to achieve. We are working closely with Maricopa County and Arizona Department of Health Services (AzDHS) while under the quarantine protocol and I will send correspondence when we are able to ease into the normal COVID-19 restricted visitations, designated essential visits and small group activities.

As you can imagine, due to the increased workload and recent recovery from COVID-19, it may have been more difficult to reach the Assisted Living and Early Memory Support management team. Any critical changes in the condition of residents or any newly positive cases have been prioritized and you can be assured that we will be in direct contact with you immediately. Our testing days are on Mondays and Thursdays and have same day results; therefore, if you have not received a call from us on those days, it is safe to assume your loved one tested negative.



Per quarantine protocol, all our residents are required to stay in their rooms. There is no communal dining at this time. Activities remain suspended except for in-room activities. Only essential medical appointments should be scheduled at this time. Visitations have been suspended per AzDHS and MCHS protocol. Providers who come on campus are able to continue their services without interruption. For those who have off-campus primary care physicians, we highly recommend switching over to mobile providers at least through the pandemic so your loved one does not have to go off campus and increase the risk of exposure to COVID-19 and avoiding a mandatory 14-day quarantine upon return. Mobile providers like Mom and Dad's Mobile and Mobile Valley Physicians are aware that some residents may switch over temporarily for this reason.

Thanks to all of you for standing by the campus, for being understanding, and for being with us during this pandemic. We truly appreciate you. Please stay tuned for more updates.
