Dear Beatitudes Families and Residents,

Good afternoon/evening all. I wanted to review coronavirus vaccine news. CVS, in partnership with Maricopa County Health Services (MCHS), administered Moderna vaccines to our Assisted Living and Early Memory residents on January 26, 2021. Those who received their first dose on January 26, 2021 will receive their second dose on February 23, 2021. Those who have not yet received their first dose and have not contracted COVID-19 and have recovered 4 days after symptoms will receive their first Moderna vaccination dose on February 23, 2021. The vaccination clinic will return on March 23, 2021 to finish the vaccination process.

I am excited to share that we are now on day 8 of 14 consecutive days without any new cases of COVID-19 positives. The 14 consecutive days without a new positive is what is required to have AzDHS and Maricopa County Health Services remove us from quarantine protocol and we can return to the COVID-19 regulated norm prior to the Quarantine Protocol. With approval, we anticipate that Designated Essential Visitors can resume visits between 8 am-6 pm and outdoor visits will resume per policy starting February 12, 2021. For your convenience, I have included the policy with this email. Modified activities will also resume, including monitored outdoor time in the designated Assisted Living area. Beatitudes at Home can resume outdoor time with residents. Communal dining will remain suspended but monitored and small group dining can resume on individual floors in the common dining areas. Doctors' appointments may resume after we are off quarantine; however, off-campus appointments will still result in a 14 day quarantine upon return to Campus.

We continue to test twice weekly with our staff and residents, and we have had no new cases of COVID-19. We are working closely with Maricopa County and Az Department of Health Services (AzDHS) while under the quarantine protocol. I will send correspondence when we are able to ease into the normal COVID-19 restricted visitations, designated essential visits and small group activities.

Plaza View Assisted Living

We continue to test twice weekly with our staff and residents, and we have had no new cases of COVID-19 since January 28, 2021. We are working closely with Maricopa County and Arizona Department of Health Services (AzDHS) while under the quarantine protocol. I will send correspondence when we are able to ease into the normal COVID-19 restricted visitations, designated essential visits and small group activities.

As you can imagine, due to the increased workload and recent recovery from COVID-19, it may have been more difficult to reach the Assisted Living and Early Memory Support management team. Any critical changes in the condition of residents or any newly positive cases have been prioritized and you can be assured that we

will be in direct contact with you immediately. Our testing days are on Mondays and Thursdays and have same day results; therefore, if you have not received a call from us on those days, it is safe to assume your loved one tested negative.

Thanks to all of you for standing by the campus, for being understanding, and for being with us during this pandemic. We truly appreciate you. Please stay tuned for more updates.
