Good afternoon all,

I wanted to share some awesome news with you that will take place starting Monday, March 22, 2021. New regulations from AZ Department of Health have given us guidance for a controlled reopening. Starting Monday, you will be allowed to go into buildings throughout campus. Please keep in mind that there are capacity rules for certain buildings and some events, like the Bistro dining, which is by reservation only. Also, visitors are not allowed in most community buildings at this time. Those who are not in quarantine will now be allowed up to two visitors, 7 days a week between 8AM-6PM. Visitors are encouraged to do outdoor visits versus indoor visitation. Masks must be worn at all times, including in your room by both you and your visitor(s). Proper social distancing is required unless you have been fully vaccinated. Please keep in mind that COVID-19 is still very present in our lives, and we must stay diligent whether vaccinated or not. Remember to wear your masks, practice social distancing and keep your hands clean.

Also starting Monday, March 22, 2021, Plaza View dining will resume in the first floor dining room. To control capacity and ensure social distancing, it will be by reservation only. Please call extension 16121 to reserve your seats! You still will have the option to have your meals delivered to your room. At this time, dining in Plaza View will be reserved for residents of assisted living only.

It has been a long and trying journey through this pandemic. We are still learning a lot about COVID-19, vaccine efficacy, COVID-19 variant strains, etc. and, because of this, it is important that you remain diligent in staying safe and keeping each other safe. Staying safe also helps the campus safely reopen! The light at the end of the tunnel is getting bigger and brighter, stay the course!
