## VISITATION GUIDELINES FOR REOPENING FOR BEATITUDES CAMPUS

### PLAZA VIEW ASSISTED LIVING & PIPER EARLY MEMORY SUPPORT

3/16/2021-Guidelines Subject to Change

**Statement:** With guidance from Arizona Department of Health Services (AZDHS), LeadingAge, U.S. Coronavirus Task Force, and CDC, visitation will resume based on Campus mitigation policy and level of spread as defined by benchmarks in the following areas: Community Spread and Percent Positivity. Beatitudes Campus has created visitation guidelines to best serve our residents, their families, and our staff and to maximize infection control based on Beatitudes Campus staffing and the layout of the Campus. National Standards have been set forth by the Coronavirus Task Force with three different thresholds that will define visits as defined below:

**Minimal Community Spread:** Evidence of isolated cases or limited community transmission, case investigations underway; no evidence of exposure in large communal setting.

**Moderate Community Spread:** Sustained transmission with high likelihood or confirmed exposure within communal settings and potential for rapid increase in cases.

**Substantial Community Spread:** Large scale, controlled community transmission, including communal settings (e.g., schools, workplaces).

## Visitation at Congregate Settings for Vulnerable Adults and Children

As depicted by the data above, visitations will take place during every status with stipulations. Assisted Living is currently above 70% of residents fully vaccinated. If an outbreak occurs or if your loved one is under quarantine, visitations would be suspended until status returns to normal per CDC guidelines. A compilation of COVID data over a two-week period and current facility positivity rate defines visitation. Please carefully read requirements listed below.

**Requirements:** Visitation at Plaza View Assisted Living and Virginia G. Piper Early Memory Support may be allowed if the following conditions are met:

- Outside visits are the preferred method of visitation.
- The visitor attests that they have not had known exposure to COVID-19 in the last 14 days prior to visit and remains free from symptoms.
- The visitor must limit contact with residents and staff and must maintain at least 6 feet distance. If your loved one has been fully vaccinated, then it is their option to have close physical contact.
- Beatitudes Campus requires approved mask-wearing at all times including while in the resident rooms. Visitors must provide their own mask and cannot be a handkerchief, bandana, neck gaiter, or vented face covering. An N95 or surgical mask or three-ply cloth mask are recommended.
- Beatitudes Campus requires hand sanitizing prior to the visit and after the visit.
- Visitor must sign visitor log maintained by Beatitudes Campus in Plaza View lobby for contact tracing purposes.
- Beatitudes Campus institutes enhanced cleaning and sanitation of visitation spaces.
- Visitors may only visit their loved ones and cannot visit multiple residents unless approved by the resident or their POA.

**Process:** The following will be the process for family visits. This does not pertain to designated essential visitors.

- Up to 2 visitors per visit.
- Social distancing (6 feet apart) must be maintained at all times; there can be no physical contact unless your loved one has been fully vaccinated and at which time is at their discretion.
- Upon entry they will be screened for symptoms and have temperature taken.
- After signing in and proper hand sanitizing, visitors are asked to stay in the resident's room unless going outside.
- Visitation hours, at this time, will be 8:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- For residents who have roommates, a designated area will be provided for visits. In the event there are multiple visitors at the same time, visitations will be limited to 30 minutes per visitor.

Residents with confirmed COVID-19 may not have visitors until they have met the criteria to discontinue transmission-based precautions. Residents in quarantine may not have visitors until they have met the criteria for release from quarantine. These restrictions apply whether the resident is vaccinated or not vaccinated.

Residents are permitted anywhere on Campus as long as residents remain masked at all times and proper social distancing of 6 feet is maintained and the above statement applies. Please follow all rules including reservations in restaurants and maximum capacities. Due to capacity restrictions, Plaza View dining room and Virginia G. Piper dining is restricted to Assisted Living residents only. Visitations will commence on Monday, March 22, 2021.

We are excited to see you all reunite with your loved ones and excited to see residents reconnect in person with their friends on Campus. Please keep in mind that though positivity rates are declining, and more people are being vaccinated, we are not out of the woods yet. Please stay diligent in infection control practices so we can remain healthy, safe, and most importantly open.
