There is still work to be done by all of us to end this pandemic, and we don't want to let our guard down too soon. I urge you to get vaccinated if you haven't already done so. This is the single best defense against the coronavirus. Until enough people are vaccinated, we'll still need to continue the public health measures to keep all of us safe.

We conducted an all-staff testing again this week. Of the 288 tests done, all were negative. And, we have a COVID-19 free campus this week. We are trending in the right direction! The State of Arizona is ranking one of the best in the nation with a record low seven-day case rate per 100,000 people. More than 2 million Arizonans have had at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine as of Thursday, and more than 1.3 million people are fully vaccinated. Arizona has a population of about 5.6 million adults. The data shows that 76% of adults over 75 have received at least one dose. These metrics place Arizona 28th among states and territories in vaccinated population.
