



COMMUNITY CORNER: UPDATED CAMPUS GUIDELINES AND AMENITIES May 7, 2021

Please note: The areas highlighted in **yellow** indicate the updated changes.

Plaza View Assisted Living Updates

- AL residents are free to go into other buildings and apartments on Campus, including the Bistro for dining.
- The AL dining room is now open for reservations of up to two people, but IL residents may not yet dine in the Assisted Living dining room.
- IL residents may visit residents in AL and may participate in AL activities, including Plaza View Thursday Worship. Residents will need to remain socially distanced and masked at all times **unless all members of the small group (25 people or fewer) are vaccinated.**

Independent Living Resident Gatherings

Residents may gather in small groups of 25 or fewer in individual apartments, classrooms, and lobbies. Residents gathering in small groups indoors may forgo masks and social distancing if all members of the party are fully vaccinated and agree they are comfortable forgoing masks. If any individuals in the setting are unvaccinated, all must wear masks and social distance. If you are unsure whether someone in the group is vaccinated, **assume they are not and ensure all members of the party remain socially distanced and masked.**

Visitor Guidelines

Residents may invite visitors (including children under 18) on Campus. **Small groups of residents and visitors may gather privately inside apartments and outdoors without masks if all members of the group are vaccinated. If resident guests/visitors participate in indoor events (classes, performances, etc.), all participants (residents and visitors) must be masked.**

Outdoor Entertainment

Outdoor gathering participant limits have been lifted. **Fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear masks outdoors except in crowded situations. This includes gatherings composed of vaccinated and unvaccinated participants. Unvaccinated individuals, however, must remain masked at all times (indoor and outdoor gatherings) except when eating or exercising alone.**

Life Center

Life Center capacity will be limited to 75 residents and/or staff with social distancing and masks unless the event is for 25 or fewer people (see IL Resident Gatherings section for guidelines for 25 or fewer).

- **Life Center Walking:** Open Daily 7-10AM. If residents are vaccinated, masks may be removed. Please limit walking to two residents at a time on Employee COVID Testing days.
- **Quiet Room:** The Life Center Quiet Room will be open for use on weekdays until 2PM.

Library

Hours Open: Monday through Saturday from 1PM-3PM. Masks are required.

Dining Services

Buckwald's and Bistro are open with limited dine-in seating (6 per table) and Buckwald's has limited seating hours available.

Bistro

- You must make a reservation for dine-in seating at x12908. Masks are required.
- Reservation can be made for any time between 7AM and 7PM.
- You may order in-person and wait for your order for pickup or call an order in for pickup or delivery.
- You may do a little shopping in the grab and go and convenience store area for groceries, ice cream, sandwiches, salads, and bottled beverages. There are signs on the floor throughout to help you maintain social distancing.
- The Corner Perk is open for Starbucks coffee and tea drinks as well as donuts and pastries for dine in (reservation still required) or pick-up and delivery
- Visitors/guests may dine-in at this time in the section reserved for residents with guests.

Buckwald's Arizona Grille

- Buckwald's is open for dine-in seating on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 4PM – 7PM. Reservations are required. Call ext. 16130.
- Outside guests may dine-in at this time in the section reserved for residents with guests.
- Buckwald's is open for pick up or delivery Monday through Saturday from 11 am – 2pm. Tuesday and Wednesday we are open from 4-7 for pick and delivery only.

Bistro and Buckwald's deliveries are still being offered free of charge.

Off-Campus Transportation

Call x12905 24 hours in advance to sign up for an outing.

Bus seating will now be limited to one person per seat or one couple per seat. Masks must be always worn when using campus transportation. Vehicle capacity will determine the number of residents permitted on each outing.

Life Long Learners

All Spring courses are now underway via Zoom. Watch for a Summer brochure about courses beginning in June. Several of the courses will be in-person, in-Agelink.

Salon Services

Campus salons are open for business Tuesdays through Fridays by appointment only. Call x16129 to reach the Plaza North Salon or x16193 for the Town Plaza Salon.
